The San Pedro River in Arizona is one of the few remaining free flowing rivers in the United States. It originates in Mexico and flows north through southern Arizona to its confluence with the Gila River at Winkelman, Arizona. The San Pedro River Valley provides habitat for a wide variety of species (many of which are considered threatened or endangered), serves as a globally important migratory bird flyway, and provides a livelihood to many families. Its surface and ground waters have historically provided wetland habitat, irrigation to many small farmsteads, water for livestock and wildlife, and municipal and industrial water supplies. Unfortunately, the waters of the San Pedro are rapidly declining because of historic overuse, industrialization and urbanization, und unchecked encroachment of invasives such as salt cedar and mesquite. The result is reduced water supplies, loss of fish and wildlife habitat, and water quality degradation, not to mention the degradation of one of America's truly unique natural assets.

Because of concerns within the valley of additional protections and regulation, either through conservation easements or fee purchase for mitigation requirements, the Winkelman and Redington NRCD'd formed a locally led initative with the objective of safeguarding the human and natural resources within the valley. With input from partners such as The Nature Conservancy, Arizona Game and Fish, and the Arizona Land and Water Trust, the initative has evolved inot the Lower San Pedro Watershed Initiative (LSPI) presented in this proposal.

The Vision of the LSPI is to ensure a sustainable natural resource base for future generations by promoting a voluntary culture of conservation by protecting private property rights; fostering a sustainable and resilient economy; promoting incentive based habitat conservation and species diversity; and providing for the sustainability of natural and economic resources of the Lower San Pedro River.
