Discussion Item: Hiring an attorney to represent the districts re: Line Siting Committee SunZia.

Andy Smallhouse, Bill Dunn, and Steve Turcotte met with Stan and Sun Zia representatives this week. Economic harm would have to be proved in a court of law. So, the primary concern is the effect on natural resources with options to mitigate. The goal is make sure that the Districts have a legal standing before the Line Siting Committee. Ideally, Sun Zia would follow the BLM suggested route and reclamation would be done right. So, the first step is to get a voice at the beginning of the process and be able to speak with authority / knowledge before the committee. If the Sun Zia project can't be stopped; then, mitigation would be pursued to make it part of the committee's decision. So, a list of mitigation needs would have to be made. So, an attorney, Lat Celmins, would be hired to begin the intervention process.
